The North Annville Township Board of Supervisors met at the Water Works Fire Hall at 7:30 p.m. on January 11, 2021 for the purpose of a regular monthly meeting. All members were present. Also present was: see attached attendance sheet.

Randy Leisure, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Clyde Meyer, Vice-Chairman, made a motion to approve the December 14, 2020 meeting minutes as presented in printed form. Randy 2nd the motion, motion carried. Randy then made a motion to adopt the December 14 Treasurer's Report as presented in printed form. Clyde 2nd the motion, motion carried. Adam Wolfe, Secretary-Treasurer, read all the bills for the month. Adam made a motion to pay all bills as read. Clyde 2nd the motion, motion carried. Randy stated that the minutes of the January 4, 2021 supervisor's reorganization meeting are available at the door. Each of the three supervisors will retain the same office that was held in the year 2020.

Next, Paul Bametzreider, Township Solicitor, stated that he sent notices to the property owners who failed to comply with the on-lot disposal system pumping requirements. The notice gives the property owner 30 days to respond before the Township will place a municipal lien against the property in order to recoup costs and fees associated with obtaining on-lot disposal system pumping compliance.

For the next item of business, Paul stated that he found valuable information regarding net-metering solar operations and is working on putting a draft ordinance together for review by the Planning Commission and supervisors. Randy stated that Kurt Yordy will be required to submit an application, which could require the payment of a large fee, to Met-Ed's solar department. Paul stated that the booklet he is reviewing goes into detail about the required application.

Next on the agenda, Tammy Blauch provided an update from the Emergency Services Advisory Committee by stating that the Union Water Works Fire Co. spreadsheet has been updated to reflect that the Union Water Works Fire Co. did not operate in the "red" for the years 2016-2019.

Randy stated that PennDOT will be using traffic counters to collect data on municipally owned roads between January 2021 and April 2021. The data collection will not be part of any road project or speed detail. For the remainder of the road report, Randy stated that dead ash trees along School Creek Lane will be removed as the contractor's schedule permits.

No Planning Commission business was presented for discussion.

For the police report, Chief Farneski stated that the case of illegal dumping on Laurel Grove Rd. has been resolved, with the Court requiring restitution to be paid to the Township. Lastly, a resident of Heisey Rd. recently committed suicide on Syner Rd.

For the fire company report, Randy extended a thank you to the Bellegrove and Union Water Works Fire Companies for the outstanding service they provide to North Annville Township.

No Zoning Hearing Board business was presented for discussion nor were any public comments.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
