

NORTH ANNVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION

MINUTES OF JANUARY 7, 2019

The North Annville Planning commission met at the Township Building on January 3, 2018 for a regularly scheduled meeting. Members of the Commission in attendance were: Randy Leisure, Ben Bow, Nelson Heagy, Brian Keck and Charlie Bomgardner.

Nelson Heagy called the meeting to order at 7:31 pm.

A motion was made by Ben Bow, and seconded by Charlie Bomgardner, to approve the minutes of December 3, 2018. The motion was approved unanimously.

Since it was the reorganization meeting for the township supervisors, the commission voted to retain officers as follows: Chairman: Nelson Heagy; Representative to the commission from township supervisors: Randy Leisure; Vice Chairman: Charlie Bomgardner and Secretary: Brian Keck (we need to update contact sheet). Ben Bow was reelected for another 4 year term.

The commission received correspondence from Gannet Fleming representing Annville Township Sewage Treatment Plant. The Plant was notifying the township that they will be installing a centrifuge for dewatering biosolids.

The North Annville Township Supervisors received correspondence from Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection that the state has received a water application from Pennsylvania American Water to purchase .8 million gallons per day from the city of Lebanon Authority thru connection in Annville Township. The letter asked for any comments on the proposed allocation within 30 days of the application. Brian Keck as secretary of the commission will send stating the North Annville Township Supervisors have no comment at this time.

The township received a letter from Susquehanna Valley Construction who will be replacing the bridge of the Quittaphilla Creek on Palmyra-Bellegrove Road. This section of Palmyra-Bellegrove Road will be closed for approximately 200 days. Syner Road will remain open for the majority of the time of this project with some small one or two day closures.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 pm.
