2. Within thirty (30) days following receipt of the complete record as required in Paragraph 1 above, Lebanon Solar I, LLC may file a Motion Seeking a Factual Hearing before this Court. Lebanon Solar I, LLC is reminded that it should include specific reasons why it believes an additional Factual Hearing is required.
 3. Within ten (10) days following a request by Lebanon Solar I, LLC for a Factual Hearing, the Township shall be permitted to submit any objection it may have to the scheduling of a new hearing.
 4. Within sixty (60) days from today's date, this Court will determine whether the above-referenced dispute should be resolved via a Factual Hearing or via legal briefs and argument.
