The North Annville Township Board of Supervisors met at the Water Works Fire Hall at 6:30 p.m. on Jan. 2, 2024 for the purpose of reorganization. Members present included Clyde Meyer and Adam Wolfe. Randy Leisure was absent. Also present was: see attached attendance sheet.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Clyde Meyer. Clyde made a motion to approve the Jan. 3, 2023 meeting minutes as presented in printed form. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Adam made a motion to appoint Randy Leisure as Chairman, Clyde Meyer as Vice-Chairman and Road Master, and Adam Wolfe as Secretary-Treasurer for 2024. Clyde 2nd the motion, motion carried.

A motion was made by Clyde to appoint Fulton Bank and PLGIT as our financial institutions for the year 2024. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Clyde made a motion to appoint Paul Bametzreider from the law firm of Barley Snyder as solicitor for 2024. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Adam made a motion to appoint Roberta Santiago from the law firm of Henry & Beaver as the Zoning Hearing Board Solicitor for 2024. Clyde 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Clyde made a motion to appoint Chrisland Engineering as general Township engineer for 2024, with Becker Engineering to be retained as the Township engineer for sewer-related matters. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Clyde made a motion to appoint Becker Engineering to complete the Annual Chapter 94 Report on behalf of North Annville Township. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Clyde made a motion to appoint James Hoffman, Paul DeShong and Gary Tshudy as Zoning Hearing Board members for 2024, with Eric Brummer to serve as the alternate Zoning Hearing Board member for 2024. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Next, Clyde made a motion to appoint Calvin Hostetter as machine operator for 2024, with an hourly wage of \$23.00, and also to continue mowing the road banks three times per year. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

The treasurer's bond was set at \$1,500,000.00 and is carried by the Ohio Casualty Co. Adam made a motion to continue the bond, 2nd by Clyde. Motion carried.

The meeting dates for 2024 were set earlier and advertised according to law.

Yearly donation amounts were then discussed. Clyde made a motion to donate \$17,000.00 to each of the Bellegrove and Water Works Fire Companies and \$8,500.00 to the Bellegrove Life Squad for 2024. Adam 2nd the motion, motion carried.

On a motion by Clyde, 2nd by Adam, the regular annual donation to the Annville Free Library for 2024 was set at \$7,500.00. Motion carried. It was also noted that the second of five library expansion project annual donation payments of \$5,000.00 each will be made in 2024.

Adam then made a motion to appoint John R. Poff, William Smeltzer and Patrick Brewer to the Building Code Appeals Board, with Rick Horst as the alternate. Clyde 2nd the motion, motion carried.

On a motion by Clyde, 2nd by Adam, Stephen McNamara was appointed as North Annville Township Emergency Management Coordinator for 2024.

Next, on a motion by Clyde, 2nd by Adam, Charlie Bomgardner was appointed to a four year term and Randy Leisure to a one year term on the Township Planning Commission. Randy shall serve as the Supervisor Representative on the Planning Commission. Motion carried.



There being no further business, Adam made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 p.m. Clyde 2nd the motion, motion carried.
